Originally called Armistice Day, marked the end of World War I at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918. In 1954, its name changed to Veterans Day to honor both living and deceased American veterans of all wars. Unlike other holidays, this day honors all military veterans who served honorably in any branch of the military, regardless of whether their service was in wartime or peacetime.

- Please try to join us Tuesday, November 11th, as we honor our Veterans with a program at Veterans Memorial (on Veterans Parkway) at 11:00 am. Rain or shine the program will be held.

-Saturday, December 13th, 2025, is Wreaths Across America Day. The organization began in 1992 when wreath-maker Morrill Worcester had a surplus and donated 5,000 wreaths to be placed on graves at Arlington National Cemetery. The tradition grew annually, and a photo of the wreaths in the snow went viral in 2005, significantly boosting public interest; in 2007 the Worcester family and volunteers formed the nonprofit Wreaths Across America to expand the effort to honor fallen veterans nationwide, leading to Congress declaring the third Saturday in December as "Wreaths Across America Day" in 2008.

-Our local Wreaths Across America program will start 10:00 am at the Hillside Cemetery in Marshfield.

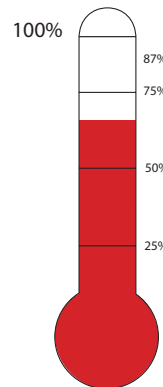

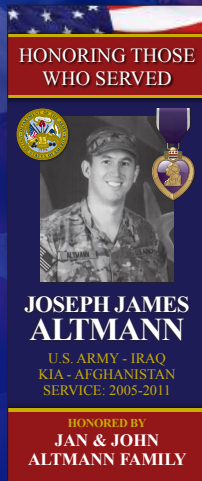
